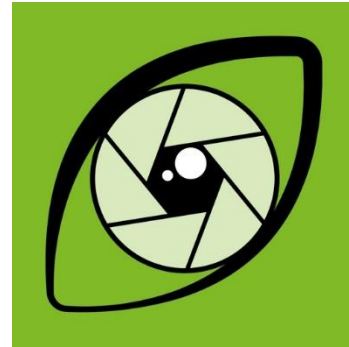


Instant Wild: Explore habitats, adaptations and food chains
