- Bluey and Bingo will be at the Zoo from 29 May to 2 June at intervals throughout the day.





Entering the Event

- This event will take place in the elephant arena.
- You may need to queue before you find your seat.
- There is no assigned seating.
- There is a carpark next to the arena for everyone to use.



Activity Times



- There are 5 sessions per day at the following times:
 - 11am*, 12pm, 2pm, 3pm and 4pm.
- The sessions start promptly, so please arrive 15 minutes before the session you want to see.
- Each session lasts 15 minutes.



*Gold members, Fellows, and Patrons will have priority access to the first Bluey and Bingo session each day.

Important Information



- After the session, please stay in your seat. A member of staff will call your row when it is time to leave.
- On the way out you may have the chance to high-five Bluey and Bingo.
- You will not be able to take a picture with or hug the characters.
- You do not have to touch the characters if you don't want to.

Considerations



- After each session Bluey and Bingo can only stay for 15 minutes. They may need to leave before they get to meet everyone.
- The elephant arena is outside. The seats are made of stone so they may be cold. If it is raining, there is no shelter to keep you dry.
- The show may be loud.



Additional Information



- There will be space at the top of the elephant arena where you can watch the session away from the crowds and noise if you need it.
- Accessible seating will be available in the first row.
- We have ear defenders available if you need them. Please just ask a member of staff on the day.
- If you feel unwell or need help, ask a member of staff for help.
