- We will have relaxed sessions on the last Sunday of the month (July 28 and August 25). These run from 9.30am 10.30am.



# **Entering the Event**



- This event will take place in the events hub.
- The space is open 10.30am 5.30pm.
- There will be arts and crafts, giant games and performances every day.
- The performances change regularly so please check the signage around site.



#### Activities

In the event hub there are lots of free activities:

- Giant games such as vines and ladders and marbles
- A conservation station
- Puppet station where you can learn how to use an Indonesian puppet
- Craft station where you can make your own shadow puppet.

These all run 10.30am to 5.30pm

## Activities

- There will be music in this space (except for during the relaxed sessions).
- There are ear defenders available should you need them.
- There will always be 2 members of staff (dressed in blue like in the picture) who will be happy to help you. There may also be volunteers around who will be dressed in red.
- Staff and volunteers are there to monitor the activities and will only interact with you if you ask for help.
- There are instructions for all of the games on the surrounding fences, or you can ask a staff to help you learn how to play.





#### Competition

There are 5 boards placed around site by animal habitats (elephants, tigers, Asian rhinos, otters and in monkey forest). They will be clearly marked by big flags (as seen in the picture on the right).

Using the shadow puppets, you made in the events hub take photos by the boards to tell a story. You can submit your photos to **events@zls.org** to enter into our competition. There will be one winner who will be chosen after the summer holidays, the prize is an animal experience!

If you don't have or don't want to make a shadow puppet, there are puppets attached to the board that you can use so you can still enter the competition.

## Performances



- All performances will take place on the stage area by the big orange tent.
- There will be beanbags and picnic benches for you to sit on.
- On hot days there is no shade in this area so you may need to wear a hat.
- There will be music for all performances.
- You will not have to queue, just find yourself a seat and enjoy.
- These sessions may be busy. The area allows audiences of up to 120 people.
- We have ear defenders available should you need them.
