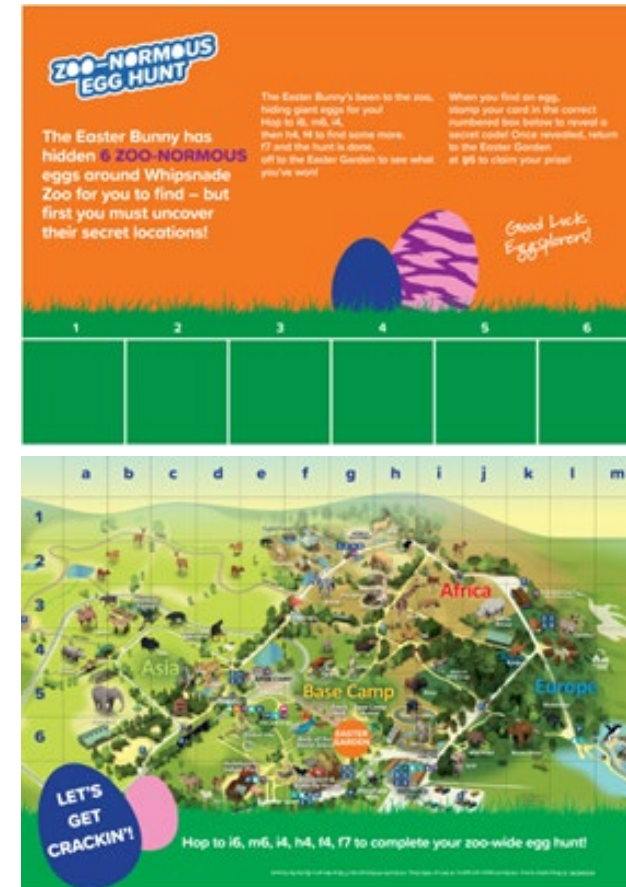

# Zoonormous Egg Hunt

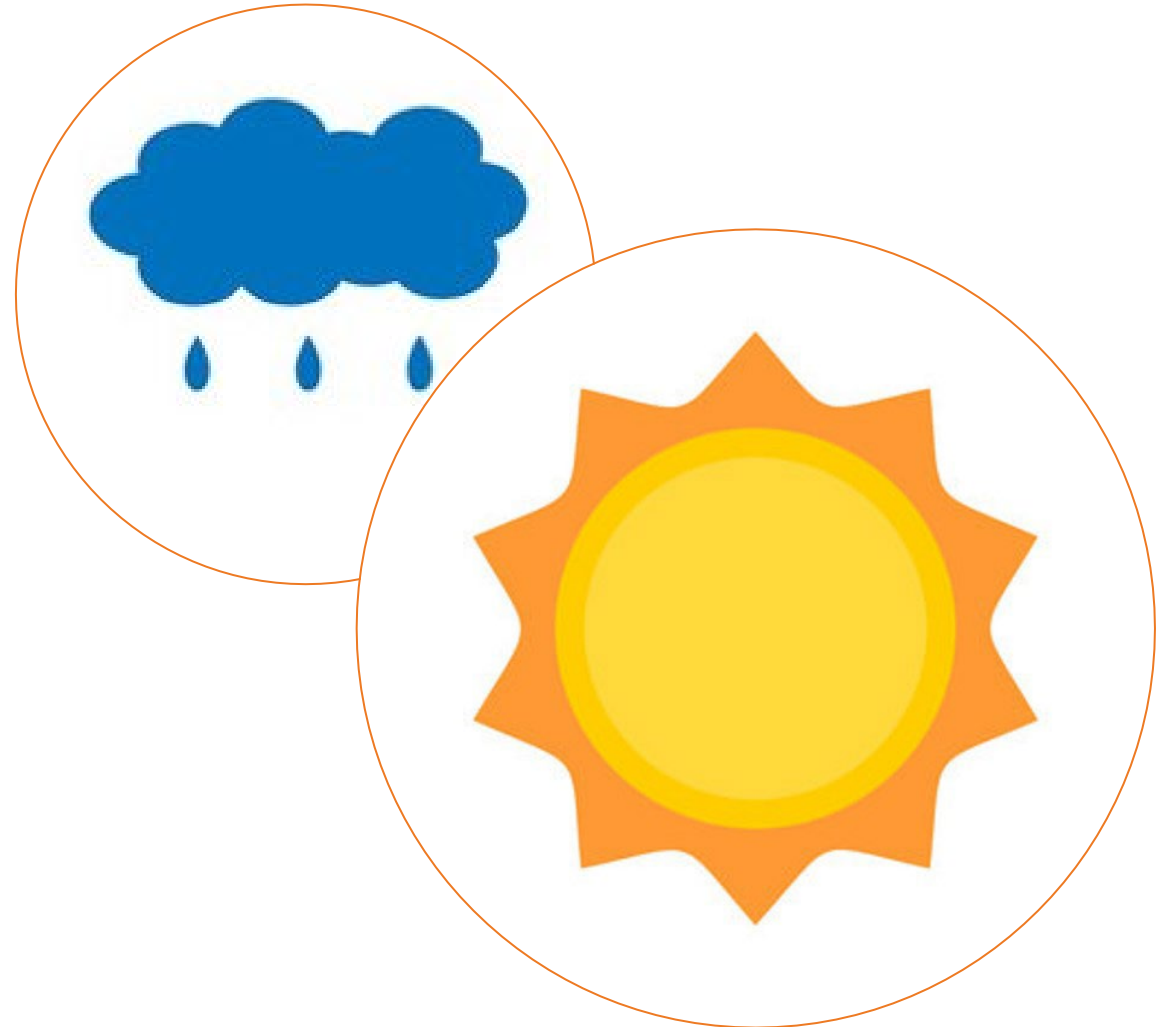
- This trail is primarily self-led and it is open in line with the Zoo's [opening times](#).
- There are 6 giant eggs for you to find. You will collect a stamp at each one.
- You can collect the trail card, which has a map and coordinates of the eggs, from the Visitor Centre when you arrive.
- Once you have collected your stamps you can go to the Easter Garden to get a prize.

# Weather

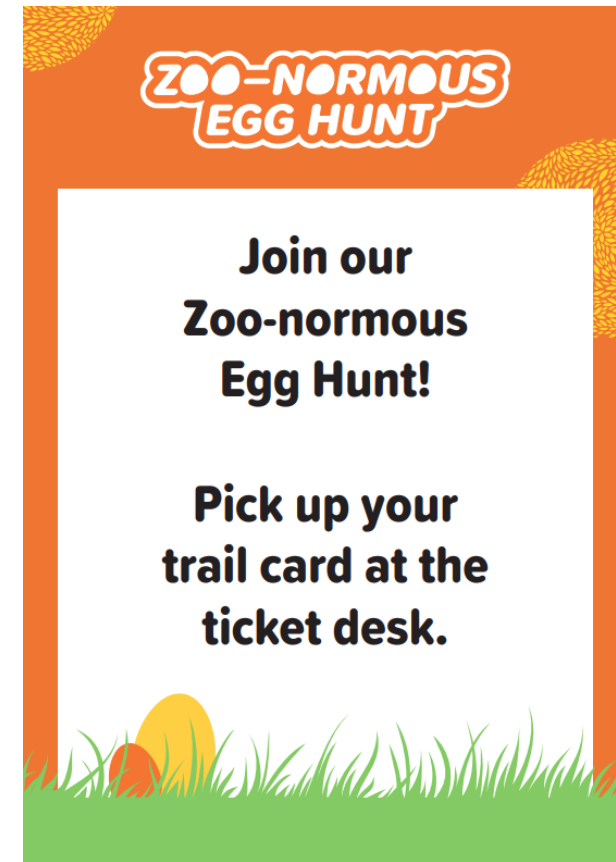
- This event is outside. There is no shelter.

- They will be marked by giant eggs and boxes like the one in the picture.

- There will be crafts available. You can do them in the garden or take them home.
- The Easter Garden is open **11am – 5.30pm.**
